Bye Laws (Updated 3-3-2017)

Issued subject to Corporation Regulation and Bye-laws

All members are expected to ensure the security of the clubhouse and to uphold the rules and bye laws at all times.

KEYS MUST NOT BE DUPLICATED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES

Loss of clubhouse door and locker keys should be reported to the secretary as soon as possible.

A charge of £5.00 will be made for new and replacement keys. Refundable when returned.

Male & Female Players Dress Code

Hard or block heeled footwear must not be worn on the green in any match played under the association's jurisdiction. Suitable footwear must be worn on the green.

The following is the only permitted dress for the Association Knockout Cup, Boyes Cup, Hospital Cup and Rose Bowl Doubles run by the Association.

Trousers: These shall be full length single coloured trousers. Studs, rivets and zipped pockets are not allowed or external pockets on the legs.

Shirts : These shall be club shirts or single coloured top with sleeve and collar and may be embellished with any or all of the following: Players name, Club / County / Manufacturers insignia.

Where necessary, sweaters which conform to the above and or wet weather gear may be worn. In team contests it is strongly recommended that uniform clothing is worn by all members. Nothing in the above shall be interpreted to allow the wearing of track suits, shell suits or denims. Any player failing to conform to this standard will be prevented from playing (or continuing) in the competition.

During competitive matches the rule regarding phones and smoking on the green will be upheld.

KITCHEN – Members using the kitchen at any time are expected to leave the kitchen in a clean and tidy condition

GREEN TIMES – 9.30A.M. TO DUSK Except on match or competition days when times will be decided by the committee.

At no times should members obstruct maintenance of the green e.g. Cutting, Watering etc. and no game should begin until such work has finished
